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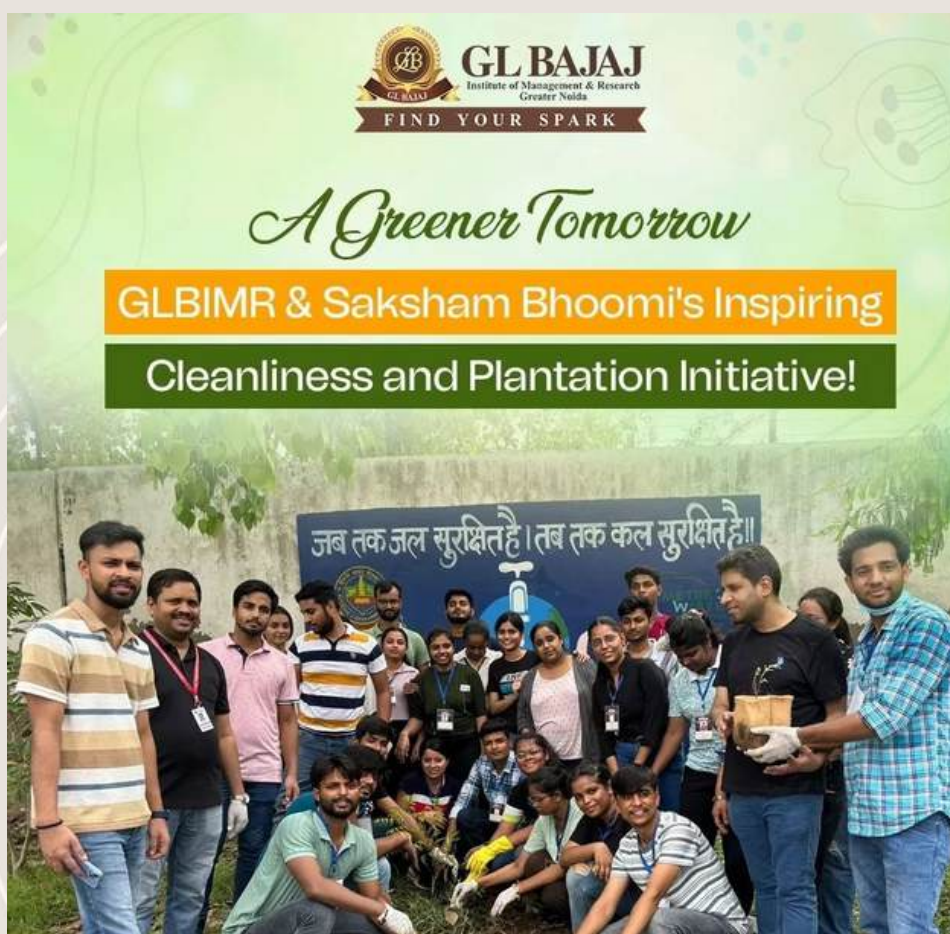

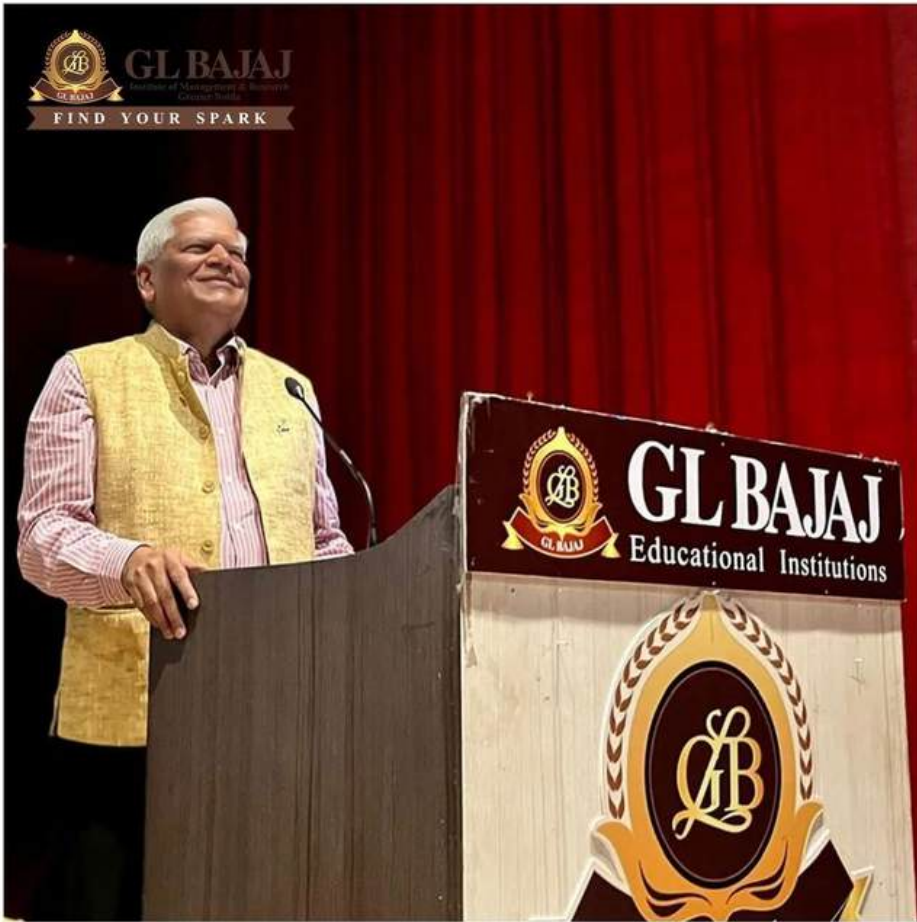

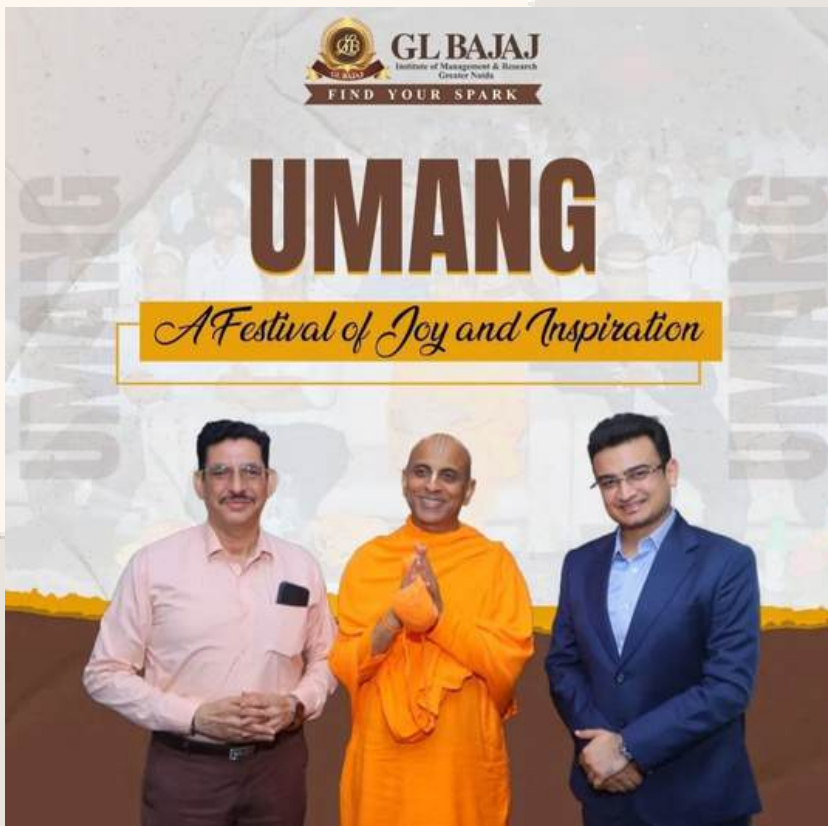




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## GLBIMR Hosts Empowering UMANG Event in Collaboration with ISKCON Youth Club-YUVA: Leadership and Mind Control Insights

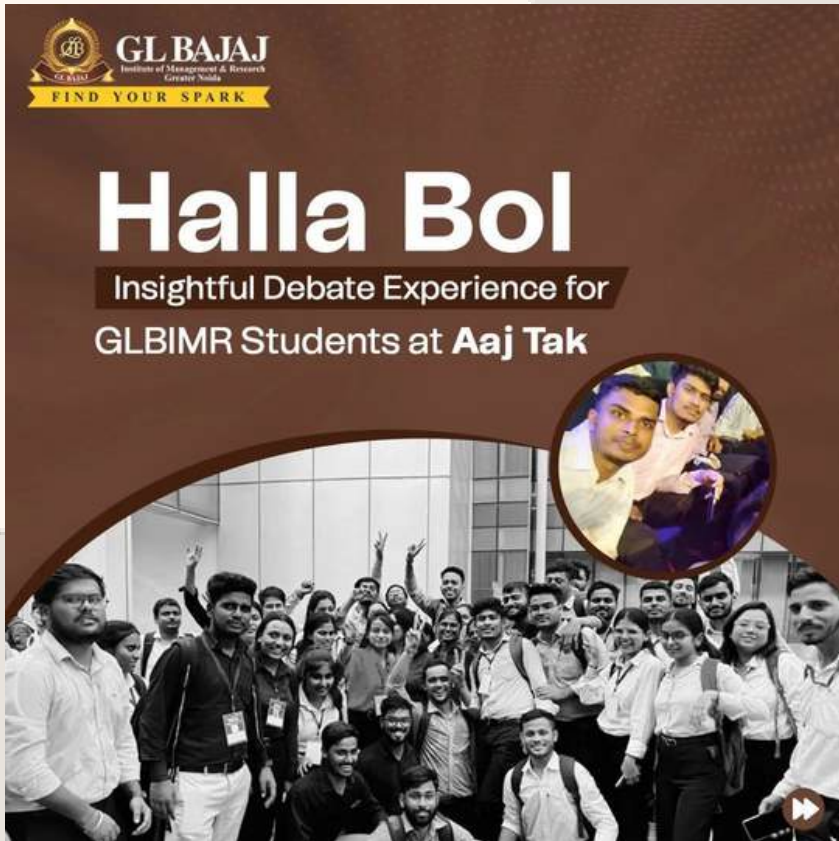




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## GLBIMR students participated in Aaj Tak's "Halla Bol" debate, gaining valuable insights into key socio-economic issues.
